Pleasant Mount Historical Society

The Pleasant Mount Historical Society was established in 1985 by a small group of local citizens interested in preserving the history of the town. To date, the society has over one hundred members and has completed many successful initiatives, including updating and preserving Samuel Meredith Park, adding "Welcome to Pleasant Mount" signs to the village, dedicating the Sarah Mary Benjamin historical marker, and much more.

In the Spring of 2003, the Pleasant Mount Historical Society acquired the O'Hara House, in the village of Pleasant Mount, through the generosity of the O'Hara family and a capital campaign spearheaded by Dan and Alice O'Neill. This project would not have been possible without the proceeds from a very successful commemorative throw fundraiser and the annual Buddy Caffery Memorial Golf Tournament.

The Society has been hard at work, restoring the building to its former grandeur, and establishing a museum to preserve and display the many local antiques and historical items the Society maintains. The restored home serves as the home of the Society as well as the heart of local family and area history.

Costello Monahan Brown American Legion Post #964

The American Legion was chartered by Congress in 1919 as a patriotic, mutual-help, war-time veterans organization, focused on serving the community.

Organized in 1946 and chartered in 1950 with 40 members, American Legion Post 964 is more active than ever in Pleasant Mount, carrying out many projects and offering services to benefit the local community.

The post was named for Francis Costello, killed in action in WWI and John Monahan, the first of seven killed in WWII. On June 18, 2005, the post name was changed to Costello Monahan Brown, in honor of Andrew Brown, a member of the 509th Parachute Infantry, who died October 8, 2004 of wounds he sustained on October 1 while fighting for Iraqi freedom.

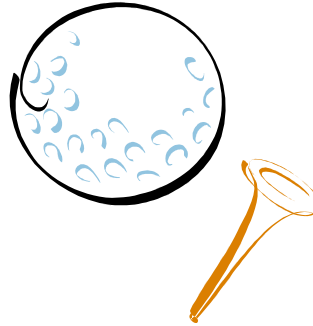
